

You can access and log into Canvas either by going through the web browser (canvas.vt.edu) or through OneCampus. When you log-in you will see your Dashboard. Students enrolled in classes (i.e. Math 1524) are automatically added to the accompanying course canvas site when the course site has been published by the instructor. Most instructors choose to not publish the course site until the first week of classes. Departments, academic advising, and student organizations also create Canvas sites to publish important information.



There will be instances in which you are manually enrolled in courses. When this occurs you will receive an email notifying you that you have enrolled in a Canvas course and containing (1) the canvas URL, (2) your email address to use for your login (2) , and (3) the blue "Get Started" button that you click to accept the course invitation.

Accepting Course Invitations



Canvas will take you to your course and ask you to accept the enrollment. Click the green “Accept” button. You may also see this notification at the top of your Dashboard when you log into Canvas.






Some instructors may choose to post announcements to remind students about upcoming assignments, content to review for class, etc. Typically you receive posted announcements through your email but if you click "Announcements" on the Course Navigation Menu you can view and filter announcements in this course. Announcements are listed in reverse chronological order with the newest appearing first. To view the announcement, click the name of the announcement.

How to Check Canvas Notifications



You can customize the notifications you receive via email from Canvas. Click “Account” from the toolbar on the left hand side of your Dashboard and then select “Account. From there you will click “Notifications” and make sure the bell is green next to “Announcement”. This will ensure that any announcement posted in any of the courses your enrolled in, you will receive as an email to your VT email address.

Canvas Profile



Within your account you can edit your Canvas profile which allows you to upload a profile picture, list a preferred name and any other personal information you may choose to list.
