

You then scroll down to view your search results below and if the class is being offered that term you will see a list of sections. I am going to break down what each column means.

Terminology



CRN (Course Request Number)

Unique number assigned to a section of a course

Schedule Type

The type of instruction of the course (i.e. lecture, lab, etc.)

I'll quickly run through some terms you'll see on your schedule. The first is CRN. This stands for Course Request Number and is a unique number assigned to the section of a course. The schedule type is the type of instruction of the course it could be a lecture, lab, independent study, recitation, or research.

Modality

How the course instruction is delivered

Credit Hours/Credits

Number of hours of credit you'll receive for completing the course

The modality is how the course instruction is delivered, which we'll get more into that later. Credit hours refers to the number of hours of credit you'll receive for completing the course, most courses at Virginia Tech are 3 credits and labs are usually 1, although this may vary.

Terminology



Seats

The number of seats still available for each section

Capacity

Maximum number of seats for the class section

Seats are the number of seats still available for each section where capacity is the maximum number of seats for each section of the class.

Understanding Modality



Face-to-Face

(On-campus F2F 76-100%)

Course will be offered in the traditional in-person format and all course meetings will be held in the assigned classroom

Hybrid (On-campus F2F 2-49%)

Course will be offered in both an in-person and online format

Modality and instructional methods are outlined here. Face to face will be a traditional in-person class held in the assigned classroom. Hybrid classes will have both an in-person, face to face, component at the location on your schedule as well as an online portion. For hybrid classes, it's very important that you read your syllabus and check the course comments to see to how much of the course is in person or online since there can be so much variety depending on the course.

Understanding Modality



Online with Synchronous Meetings (Off-campus F2F 0-1% Sync)


Course will be offered online and will have course meetings at the assigned day/time as reflected on your schedule

Online: Asynchronous
(Off-campus F2F 0-1% Async)

Course will be offered online and will not have set meeting day/times

Online with synchronous meetings means the course will be online, but you will still need to login to class at the assigned time listed on your schedule. So yes, if you have an 8am online synchronous class you still will get up early. But, if you have an online asynchronous class, you won't need to go to that class at a certain time since there is no set meeting time!




As you plan your schedule, make sure you take note of the prerequisites and/or course restrictions by clicking on the hyperlinked CRN number. To avoid registration errors when you register, double check to see if you are either missing the required prerequisites or if the section is restricted to specific majors, college, minors, class standings, etc. Not all of the sections of a particular class may be restricted, so keep clicking on CRNs and reviewing the course restrictions.

The Timetable also displays the instructor of each section, what days of the week the class is taught, the start and end times for each section, and the classroom building and room number. Remember on the top left corner of the Timetable there is a hyperlink directing you to a resource that can help you determine the building names. When you look at the day classes are offered, there are letters denoting days of the week. M is Mondays, W is Wednesdays, T is Tuesdays, R is Thursdays and F is Fridays.

Perhaps you're still looking at the Timetable and notice the column on the far right labeled "Exam". Have no fear, that's just the exam code for final exams during finals week at the end of the semester. This indicates when your final exam for the course will occur.
